

Coarse Fishing



You can purchase fishing tickets from our Fishing Warden (cash only) at the fishing lakes or at the Reception & Shop (card & cash payments). You don't need to have a booking with us to fish at our lakes, but you will need a barrier card (£10 deposit) to access the lakes by car.

Bait Rules

- No particle bait (tiger nuts)
- No chum mixer, dog biscuits or cat food
- No bait to be discarded in the water
- Maximum 1 kilo of dry ground bait
- No live bait, spinners, plugs or dead bait
- Boilies to be used in moderation



Types of fish stocked in our lakes



The lakes are well stocked with commercial sized carp averaging 6-10lb with several going to mid-teens and rising up to 22lb. There are also other species, including Bream, Tench, Roach, Rudd, Perch, Gudgeon and Sturgeon.

FISHING RULES:

- No night fishing
- No keep nets or carp sacks
- No line over 15lbs
- Maximum hook size 10, no barbed hooks
- No fires or barbeques
- No cutting of trees or reeds around swims
- All rubbish to be placed in the bins provided
- No radios or televisions
- Children aged 12 and over need a Junior Licence
- Dogs must be well behaved and kept on a lead at all times
- Any one person may use no more than two rods at any one time
- No angler shall leave a baited rod unattended in or out of the water
- Rod licenses must be carried at all times
- All children under 14 years of age are to be accompanied by an adult at all times
- No wading or swimming in the lakes under any circumstances
- Persons making excessive noise or causing annoyance to others will be asked to leave
- All fish are to be laid on mats for unhooking, not on the ground
- If you wish to fish before 9am, you must purchase your ticket the day before along with a barrier card at £10 to gain access to the park. This is refundable on return
- Anyone found breaking these rules will be asked to leave promptly by the Fishing Warden or any other member of staff
- Landing nets must be used at all times.
- Any persons leaving vehicles or entering the fishery do so at their own risk
- We do not accept any liability for any damage, loss or injury to you or any member of your party or any vehicles or possessions, unless proven to be caused by a negligent act by ourselves or our employees or contractors whilst acting in the course of employment.
